

## Attributes of CK Chiangus

Chiangus cattle are a composite breed made up of Chianina and Angus in varying percentages. CK Chiangus cattle generally consist of 15 to 25% Chianina and Angus makes up the rest. We let our environment find that % range for us as we have not selected for any certain percentage. These cattle are multi-generation Chiangus. You may have to go back more than 30 years to find a full blood Chianina animal in many of their pedigrees. Due to this, almost all CK Chiangus cattle are homozygous Black and Polled. Our Chiangus bulls tend to have slicker hair coats and a more muscular type than Angus, as well as a longer growth curve than Angus. These factors add more value to feeder cattle and that is why I continue to breed Chiangus, Added Value for the commercial cattleman.
